

FLASHLIGHT SAFARI

DIRECTIONS:

Create Your Safari Scene

1. Place the Safari Scene Template in the plastic bag. You might need to cut the sides of the bag to make it fit.
2. Using a permanent marker, trace the safari scene onto the plastic bag OR trace another scene OR just draw your own scene using your imagination.
3. Color in your scene with permanent markers.
4. Remove the template.
5. Insert the black (or dark blue) piece of construction paper into the bag (again, you might need to cut the sides of the bag or the paper to make it fit). Your scene will look very dark. In fact, it might be hard to see at all. That's okay! It's supposed to look like that.

Create Your Flashlight

1. Draw a cone shape on the white paper. It should be about 4 inches across at the wide part of the cone and about 2 inches across at the narrow part.
2. Cut out the cone and set it aside.
3. Cut out a rectangle from a piece of colored construction paper. This is your flashlight.
4. Draw some knobs on the flashlight.
5. Tape the handle of your flashlight to the white cone. The white cone is the light from your flashlight.

MATERIALS:

- 1 Large Plastic Ziplock Bag (a small one can also be used)
- 1 Piece of Black (or dark blue) Construction Paper
- 1 Small Piece of Construction Paper-any color (about 4" x 2". This will be the handle of your flashlight)
- 1 Piece of White Paper (or white card stock)
- Scissors
- Permanent Markers
- Scotch Tape or Glue
- Safari Scene Template (optional)
